2010 CFN Scholarship Winners

CFN Awards Six Scholarships for the Fall Term

The 2010-11 Scholarship winners were announced at the June 5th CFN Board of Directors meeting in Irvine.

This year CFN awarded scholarships to six winners selected from a total of thirteen applicants. The Scholarship Selection Committee is made up of Bob Semm, Dave McGowan, Erik Van Fleet and is chaired by Jim Quick. Their recommendations for scholarship winners were voted on by the full board.

Daniel Lomelin

Daniel is a third time CFN Scholarship winner and the first to receive the **Dr. Raymond Peterson Memorial Scholarship**. The Peterson Scholarship, started in 2010, is awarded to the student that is pursuing a Dentistry/Medical related career and exhibits dedication to

helping others.

He has completed work for his biology minor and the requirements for a BS in Anthropology with a GPA of 3.643 in the subject. Daniel is currently enrolled in chemistry and physics classes as well as a gerontology course. He will continue his education at UNL until he is accepted into a post-baccalaureate program or into medical school with the strong hope that either will be at one of the Nebraska schools.

Kelsie Schumacher
